Dear Parent

As you know your son/daughter will be sitting internal exams after the Easter holidays. With this letter you will find a general timetable.

The exams will run from 26 April to 10 May inclusive and cover English Language, Mathematics and Science and most option subjects. These mocks will allow the students to experience examination papers for these subjects and enable us to gather valuable evidence to support the Teacher Assessed Grades that will be submitted to the examination boards later in the summer term.

Students should go to morning registration as usual and will be able to have an early lunch break if they have an afternoon exam. When not in an exam, students will be in their usual lessons.

Students will be issued with individual timetables prior to the Easter holidays giving full details of timings and venues and dealing with any clashes.

On the back of the timetable will be some important notes which students should read carefully and familiarise themselves with. Students will be expected to behave in the same way and follow the same regulations as they would during their real GCSE/external examinations. This includes ensuring that no unauthorised items are brought into the exam room including mobile phones, ipods, MP3/4 players, smartwatches or any technological/web enabled sources of information. We also ask that wristwatches are not brought into the exam room.
