- Planner
  - Used for timetables, map, and reminders / key dates.
- Ready to Learn
  - On time, correct equipment. Equipment checks in tutor time.
- Reading Books
  - Students should make sure they have a reading book in their school bags, protected by a plastic folder.

#### Attendance

- Sickness
  - Call or email the school to let us know the student will not be in school on the first and every day of their illness.
  - Absence line: 01271 349010
- Appointments
  - Bring in a letter / appointment card and a note from home.
- Holidays
  - Cannot be taken in term time. Taking an unauthorised holiday may result in EWO involvement and possible penalty fine.

#### Attendance



- Lates
  - Unauthorised lateness to school three or more times within a half term will result in after school detentions each time.
- Truancy call
  - If a student is absent and the school has not been informed, parents / carers will receive a call/text asking for a reason every hour until a response is received.

#### First Aid



- Based in the HUB
- First aider is Mrs Ayres.
- If a student has an accident or feels unwell during the school day, they should get a pink permission slip from a teacher to attend first aid.
- First aid are unable to give out pain killers.

## ParentPay



- Cashless school
- Online payment system
- Used to pay for student lunches, trips and any other payment to school.
- Parents can track what a student's lunch money is being spent on.

#### ClassCharts



Online organisation tool used for:

- Details and completion of homework.
- Recording of positive behaviour points.
- Recording of negative behaviour points.
- Students and parents have separate log on details.
- Log on details will be provided early September.

#### Homework



- Most subjects set homework once per week
- All details are saved on ClassCharts.
- A good routine helps with homework completion.
- You do not need to be an expert in all the subjects: encourage them and plan time to get the homework done.


