Vocabulary	
Technique	I have learnt a new passing <b>technique</b> today.
Travel	If I run with the ball, without dribbling, I am breaking the <b>travel</b> rule.
Pivot	I <b>pivot</b> on my landing foot to change direction when I am holding the ball.
Skill	I am improving my shooting <b>skills</b> .
Double dribble	If I dribble the ball, stop and dribble the ball again, that is called <b>double dribble</b> .
Team	I enjoy playing as part of <b>team</b> .
Competitive	When I play a <b>competitive</b> game, I like to win.
Contact	If I come into <b>contact</b> with my opponent, I am breaking the contact rule.
Set shot	A two-handed shot in basketball from the floor, is called a <b>set shot</b> .
