Say it!

Vocabulary	
Rules	I can apply my knowledge of the rules and play a basic game.
Confidence	When I am learning, I must be confident in my ability to give things a go.
Tactics	I understand the basic tactics that help improve performance when playing.
Underarm	An underarm bowl must be used when bowling.
Bowl	The bowl must be accurate and not a "no-ball".
Backstop	The backstop needs to decide where to throw the ball if it goes or is hit behind by the batter.
Obstruction	An umpire will award Obstruction half a rounder given if the fielder on the post gets in the way of the batter.
Stumping	Stumping is a way that I can get the batter out. I can stump the post they are running towards before they get there.
Batting Stance	My batting stance is important as that will help me direct the ball where I want it to go and be ready.
Rounder	I know that a rounder is scored when you hit the ball and run all the way round to 4 th post without being out.
