Irregular verbs present tense

Ir – voy, vas, va vamos, vais, van

Tener – tengo, tienes, tiene, tenemos, tenéis, tienen

Ser – soy, eres, es, somos, sois, son

Forming the past tense in the first person

Take the ar/er/ir off the infinitive

For ar verbs add é e.g. bailar - bailé
For er/ir verbs add í e.g. comer - comí
