#### Key terms



**Goods** - are things that are made to be sold. Items that exist for humans' wants and needs.



**Services** - intangible (can't touch it) tasks done by someone else to help you e.g. hairdresser.



**Producer** - is a worker who makes goods and services for other people to use and enjoy.



**Consumer** - is someone who purchases and enjoys the use of goods and services.

# How do I revise with the flashcards?

 If you don't have a box you can just use piles.

#### **USING FLASHCARDS TO REVISE** Split a box into 5 different compartments and label them 1 to 5. Place all your flashcards in compartment 1. Test yourself on a flashcard If you can correctly recall the information move the flashcard into compartment 2, if not then put it back in compartment 1. Continue to test yourself and each time you correctly recall the information, move the flashcard into the next compartment. Flashcards from compartment 1 should be reviewed daily, with flashcards from compartment 2 being reviewed every other day, compartment 3 every third day and so on. Eventually, all your flashcards will have been transferred to compartment 5 and the information they contain stored in your long-term memory.
