



Parent parking

Please be aware that cars are not permitted to access the school site to drop off or collect students, unless extenuating circumstances have been agreed. Unnecessary traffic on the school site causes congestion and potential danger to students and staff.

Please find alternative drop-off and collection points well away from the front and back entrances of the school. Bus and turning access is vital for adapted vehicles dropping off and collecting students at Pathfields School on Abbey Road and Welland House on Chaddiford Lane. Please respect the needs of their vulnerable students and those with disabilities.

You should also be aware that Abbey Road is resident permit parking only. Enforcement officers regularly issue tickets here.

School transport. Please be aware that Stagecoach operates a 'NO PASS NO TRAVEL' policy and will not allow students to travel on the bus without fare (if fare paying) or without a bus pass.
