The things in life that you CAN live without are known as your wants, but the things you CAN'T live without are called needs

Being allowed to have things which every person 'can't live without' is called having **universal human rights**.

The global organisation which first wrote down a list (a 'declaration') of these Universal Rights is the **United Nations**

The individual Rights in this declaration are called its **Articles** There are **30** (how many?) of these Rights in the declaration.

UNICEF is a global organisation which protects the rights of children

People may disagree over whether parents should be allowed to **smack** their children if they do something naughty;...

...this is because, if adults did the same thing to each other, it would be called **assault** (a violent attack).

Amigo's is a North Devon-based charity which works in a country called **Uganda**

This country is located in the middle of the continent of Africa

Also, it is **landlocked** which means it has no coastline and you cannot visit the seaside anywhere in the country.
