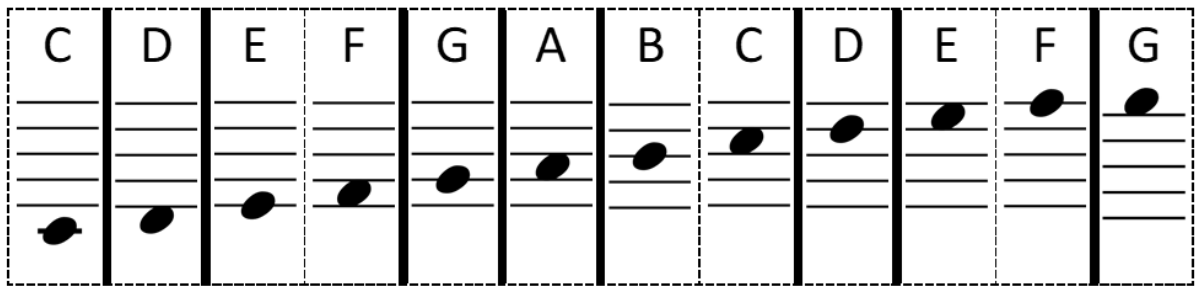


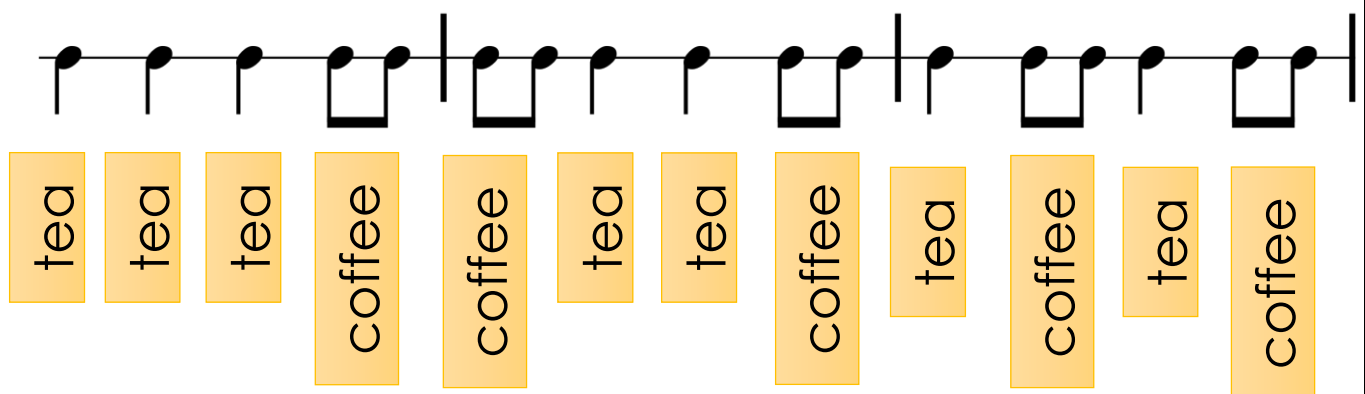
# YEAR 7 MUSIC ASSESSMENT – REVISION

You will be assessed on the following:

1. Your ability to play the correct notes of a pentatonic scale with a note ruler, To create a pentatonic scale we need to only to play the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> notes, of a major scale to make that scale's pentatonic equivalent; for example in the F Major pentatonic:



2. Your ability to play with correct rhythm; how long we hold each note. For example, we can split rhythms into words like tea for a crotchet (1 beat) and coffee for two quavers (1/2 a beat each) played one after the other; for example



3. Your ability to play a keyboard using correct technique. To accomplish this, think about which finger should play the key on the keyboard.
