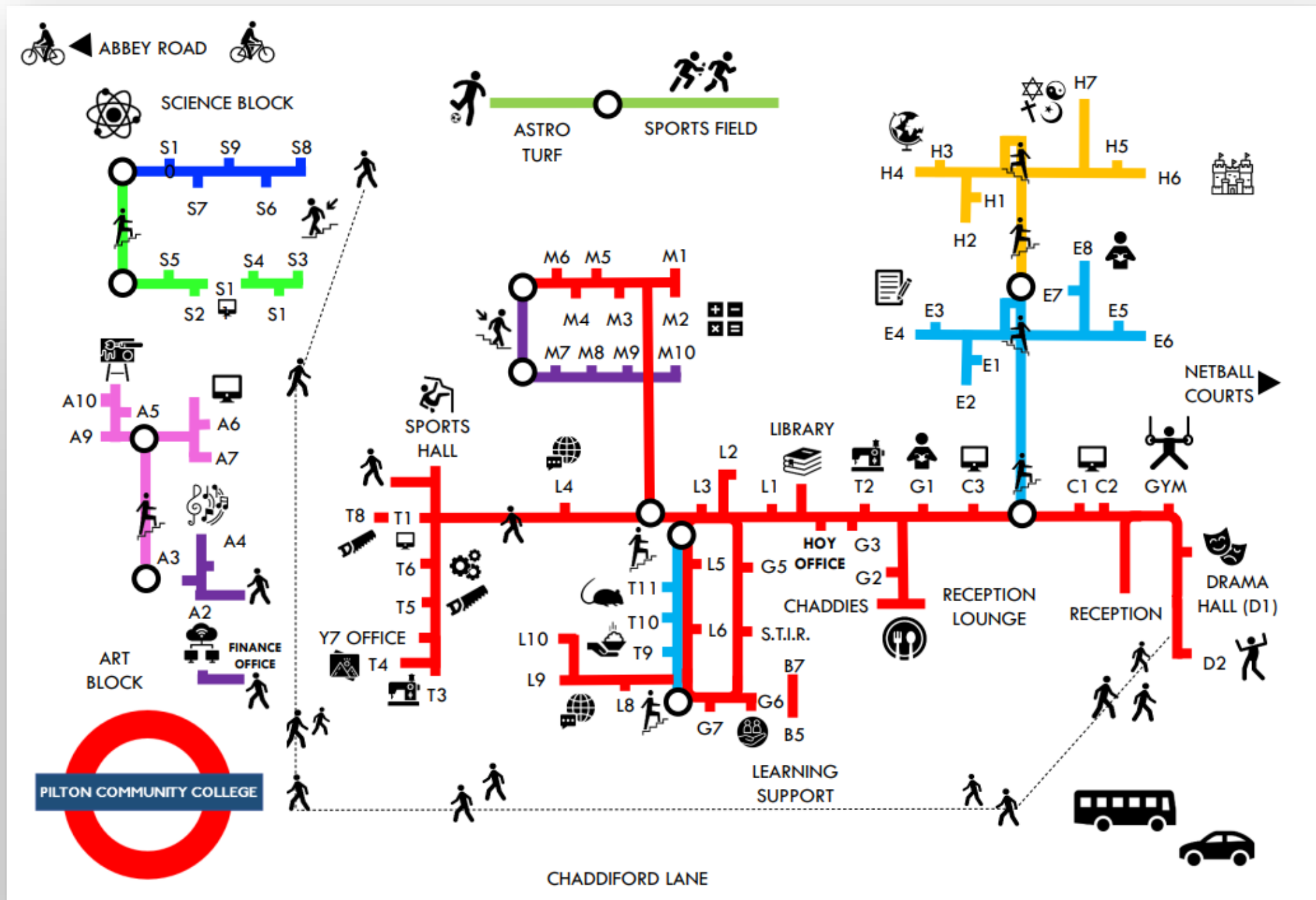


Welcome to the Pilton Community College Year Six Orienteering Challenge!
